251/22 VILLAGE NOTICEBOARDS. – **2 Quotations received.**

Councillors agreed unanimously to accept the quotation from Shelley Signs for two new noticeboards, one on the Village Green and one at Gateley.

The noticeboard on the Village Green will be the same as the existing noticeboard, with two sections, one side open and the other side will be lockable and in total will hold 32 sheets of A4, and be mounted onto posts at a cost of £1795.00.

The noticeboard at Gateley will be a smaller size, wall mounted and not lockable at a cost of £1450.00.

It was agreed that the noticeboards will not include headers.

HPC will arrange for the installation of the noticeboards.

- a. Mrs Oakley passed thanks to Mr Brooks for all of the work he has carried out at the memorial and also in the Burial Ground.
Mrs Oakley reported that there is a huge amount of soil left on the Village Green. OCC has said that they left the soil there after raising the kerb in Littleworth and have said that they will remove it and make the area good. Mr Coolman stated that OCC are also doing the bus stops in Horspath.
- b. Mr Brooks asked why the village shop wasn’t included in the village magazine. Mr Underdown stated that this was an error and it will be included in the next edition.
- c. Mr Robinson asked about the lorry that has recently got stuck on the Village Green, and stated that if the sign on the Village Green was moved to the turning circle this wouldn’t of happened. Mr Burgess stated that the lorry driver did not speak English and did not have insurance. Mrs Oakley stated that she has contacted OCC who have said that some of the lorry drivers are foreign and do not speak English, and also the sat nav’s are directing them into the village. Mrs Oakley has requested that OCC install a sign at the end of Roman Way clearly stating no right turn. Mr Lowe stated that there are 48 signs in place from leaving the ring road into Horspath.
