N.B. Not all the percentages for a question add up to exactly 100%, because they relate to the total number of questionnaires analysed, rather than the total number of answers to a specific question, and because some questions were missed out by some respondents for their households.

### **Future Development around Horspath**

The questions that follow are about the future of Horspath as a South Oxfordshire village located in the Oxford Green Belt, which is regarded by Oxford City Council and by some landowners as a suitable location for building an 'urban extension to the City of Oxford', which could join the village to the city. ## Sport and recreation

These questions ask about the levels of support for various sports facilities which might be included in the on-going plan for improved sports facilities in the village. The overall plan is to raise money from the Lottery and other charities to provide a wider range of high quality facilities for men, women, boys and girls in Horspath to play more sport, and new sports, in the village, and to encourage all residents of any age to take healthy exercise and enjoy the facilities for informal recreation. The basic scheme was published in the Horspath Parish Council Newsletter in April 2007, which is on the website www.horspath.org.uk.

The Horspath Village Sports Association, the Village Hall charity and the Parish Council approved the basic scheme centred on a second cricket pitch and two grass football pitches in the part of the Bowley Field closest to the Village Hall. Other sports facilities are now being considered, for example, an all-weather multi-sport training area designed for juniors but also open for general use, a new purpose-built energy-efficient pavilion/clubhouse/changing room, and hard tennis courts.
